Allocation of Balls

Item referred from the previous meeting

- There appear to be inequities with some events having 2 balls to all winners (as the scores were high) and some presenting 2 balls to none (as the scores were low)

- There was discussion on the allocation of balls with 2 balls being paid down to the ACR, DSR, CCR or 36 points or a % of the field
