6 Metro Veterans Representative report

Peter Green raised several issues for a recent Perth Vets Meeting.

- (a) The next City v country vets event at Mandurah will be scored using match play based on the combined stableford points of the city pair v the country pair in each group.
- (b) The 2021 AVGU event is expected to be based on Meadow Springs, Mandurah, Secret Harbour and The Cut.

6 Members Joining Small Clubs as a Means to Play Country Vets

Tim Hunter outlined the three possible resolutions to this ongoing issue which were sent to delegates prior to the meeting. These being:

- Members should be required to play X number (not yet defined but numbers between 3 and 12 have been floated) of games/year at their home Club in order to support that Club. This support should also extend to helping out at Vets games when hosted by their home Club.
- Members who do not support their home Club, ie play X number of home games, should be balloted out first when a ballot is required.
- This is a non-issue. The CVGA should not discriminate as the membership requirements and support of members is the business of each home Club. We are all equal members of the CVGA and should be treated as such.

After some discussion the recommendation that the third option above be accepted was moved by Tim Hunter and seconded by Phil Harper.

Motion was carried by overwhelming majority
